Program Focus: The City of Campbell Recreation and Community Services Department offers internships for students in the recreation major. Internship opportunities are normally during the spring or fall. There is no specific list of duties for internship. During an internship we try to expose the student to the several different parks and recreation related components offered in the various divisions of the department. Opportunities include youth and adult classes, youth and adult sports, day-camps, aquatics, fitness, special event planning, older adult (50+) programs, facility management, marketing, and administration (some opportunities are seasonal and may not be available during the students internship). Students will have an opportunity to work on projects in several of these areas. Internships are catered towards the student's area of interest along with the current needs of the department. Students will normally complete their major project in their area of interest.

Rate of Pay: Internships are normally 40 hours a week, but we are also willing to allow half-time 20 hour a week internships under some circumstances. Due to current financial conditions the City does not have a budget for paid internships, so all interns are volunteers.
