Program Focus: The program focus area and description of duties is dependent upon the time of year the student will be participating in the internship. A winter internship is typically different than a summer internship. What we do is meet with the students who are seeking internships and attempt to find out what it is that they hope to gain from the internship. We have noticed over the years that different colleges and universities have different internships, so we attempt to parallel their needs to our own. Generally, we try to get the intern to spend several weeks in each of our four different divisions so that they can gain some understanding of the differences between parks and say seniors or recreation. Interns also are generally required by the college/university to develop and complete a project during their internship. Again, we work with the student to help them achieve that objective.

Rate of Pay: Traditionally we offer an intern a 40 hour per week program with 20 hours paid and the other 20 hours volunteered. They are paid on an hourly scale of between \$10-14 per hour, based on experience.
